ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF SERVICE TO THE PARISH COUNCIL

During the last 6 months we have seen major changes on the Parish Council due to the resignation of three long standing Councillors.

In February Stewart Waterston moved away from the village. He joined the Council in June 1996 so had completed almost 20 years of service and acted as Chairman for a significant period of time. In April John Lynskey stood down after almost 10 years on the Council as he was co-opted to the Council in August

2006. In May Roger Farmer, who is also a former Chairman of the Parish Council, stood down after 17 years of service as he was first elected to the Council in May 1999.

There is no doubt that all three of these Councillors have made an enormous contribution to the village while they served the community over a long and consistent period and only too frequently this goes unrecognised. The Parish Council would like to

formally acknowledge the individual effort and dedication that they have undertaken for the people of Fincham and sincerely thank them for their service on behalf of the whole community.

They will all be greatly missed on the Council but we hope they can now enjoy a well earned rest, knowing that they have made a worthy contribution. We wish them good health and our very best wishes for the future.

DOG FOULING AND DOG WASTE BIN

It was reported at the last Parish Council meeting that incidents of dog fouling are occurring in the village. It was reported that this appears to be a particular problem on Boughton Road.

We would like to remind residents that dog owners have a legal requirement to clean up their dogs' waste. Please ensure that any dog waste is bagged and either taken home or placed in a litter bin. If you witness any incidents of dog fouling these can be reported to the Borough Council on 01553 616200 or by emailing CSNN@west-norfolk.gov.uk.

SPEED ACTIVATED MESSAGING (SAM2) SIGN FOR A1122 The Parish Council is currently considering

the joint purchase of a SAM2 sign with Crimplesham.

As previously advised these signs cost about £3000 and need to be moved to different locations within the area as they cannot be in one place for more than 4 weeks and their batteries need recharging.

Funding could be available from Norfolk County Council under the Parish Partnership scheme and if we share a sign with Crimplesham this could reduce the cost to approximately £750 each.

We are still looking for volunteers to help with moving and changing batteries. If you have half an hour to spare each month and would be willing to help please
