The Parish Council reqularly reports any problems with the roads or pavements to Highways. Any issue that is noticed and passed on to us is referred. Recently reported issues involve potholes on Downham Road, loose ironworks near The Green, damaged bridge on Boughton Road.

In recent months we have noticed that these issues have taken a while to resolve but we do continue to chase them up until the action is completed.
