CONSERVATION AREA IN FINCHAM

The conservation area in Fincham is largely the built up area to the north and south of the High Street, excluding some of the modern buildings. It extends to Fairswell Manor in the east, and a short distance up Marham Road and down Boughton Road on the east sides. To the west it includes the eastern side of Lynn Road as far as Talbot Cottages and the arboretum to Talbot Manor to the north, and to the south it ends at the track to the south-west of Sycamore House.

Any development in a conservation should be of a high standard. It will need to fit in with the character of the area. The same considerations are given to more minor proposals, such as extensions, which can spoil the appearance of a conservation area.

Within conservation areas, a number of special controls apply and therefore anyone proposing to carry out new development, al-

teration, extensions, installations or demolition should seek advice from the Borough Council Planning Department at an early stage. Special controls also apply to the trees and some may be subject to Tree Preservation Orders. Anyone wishing to carry out work on trees should seek advice from the above Planning Department.

VACANT ALLOTMENT PLOTS

The allotment plots on Marham Road were looking rather overgrown after last year and unfortunately several tenants decided to give up their plots for various reasons.

We have made arrangements for the Community Payback Team to come in and clear the vacant plots over the winter and early spring and this work has already commenced. The Team are carrying out this work free of charge and have also agreed to help with regular maintenance of the Nature Reserve.

The vacant plots will be available shortly and if you are interested in taking on a plot then please get in touch with the Clerk on the details overleaf. Plots are £21 per annum and there is a water supply at the site.

SPEED ACTIVATED MESSAGING (SAM2) SIGN FOR A1122

The Parish Council has applied for funding from Norfolk County Council to cover half of the cost of a SAM2 sign which would be shared with Crimplesham.

We expect to have a reply to our application by the end of March 2017 with funding being available from April 2017 if we are successful.

PRECEPT

The Precept is the amount of money paid to us by the Borough Council who collect it from your Council Tax.

At the last meeting of the Parish Council a decision was made to make a small increase of £300 per annum for 2017/18 to cover a shortfall in our budget, due to increased costs of grounds maintenance; for a Band D household this will mean a rise from £41.22 per annum to £42.68 which represents an extra £1.46 per annum.

The Parish Council reluctantly agreed this increase to maintain services but did agree that the cost of a SAM2 (see below left) sign should be met from reserves, if this purchase goes ahead with funding from Norfolk County Council.

NEW PARISH COUNCILLORS

The Parish Council was pleased to co-opt Barbara Ponder from Marham Road and Alan Foreman from Boughton Road to fill the two vacancies.

The second vacancy occurred due to the resignation of Tony Chivers who had been a Councillors since May 2014. We thank him for his service to the village.
