Update on SAM2 data from Marham Hill facing North (24<sup>th</sup> September – 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2020)

A total of 23,691 vehicle speeds were recorded during the four weeks that the SAM2 was up on Marham Hill facing North.


Of continuing concern is the number of vehicles travelling at speeds above 35 mph as they enter the 30 mph speed limit. Twenty four percent of vehicles were recorded at speeds of 35 mph and above which is lower than September 2019 (32%).
