

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4654) affecting the Marham Road from its junction with Churchill Crescent for 100m northwards in the PARISH OF FINCHAM to facilitate UK Power Network cabling works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 08:00 and 17:00 on the 22nd February 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 9 hours within the period.

Alternative route is via: Marham Road, Norwich Road, Lynn Road, The Green, Mill Road, Downham Road, High Street (Shouldham, Fincham, Shouldham Thorpe, Stradsett).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.

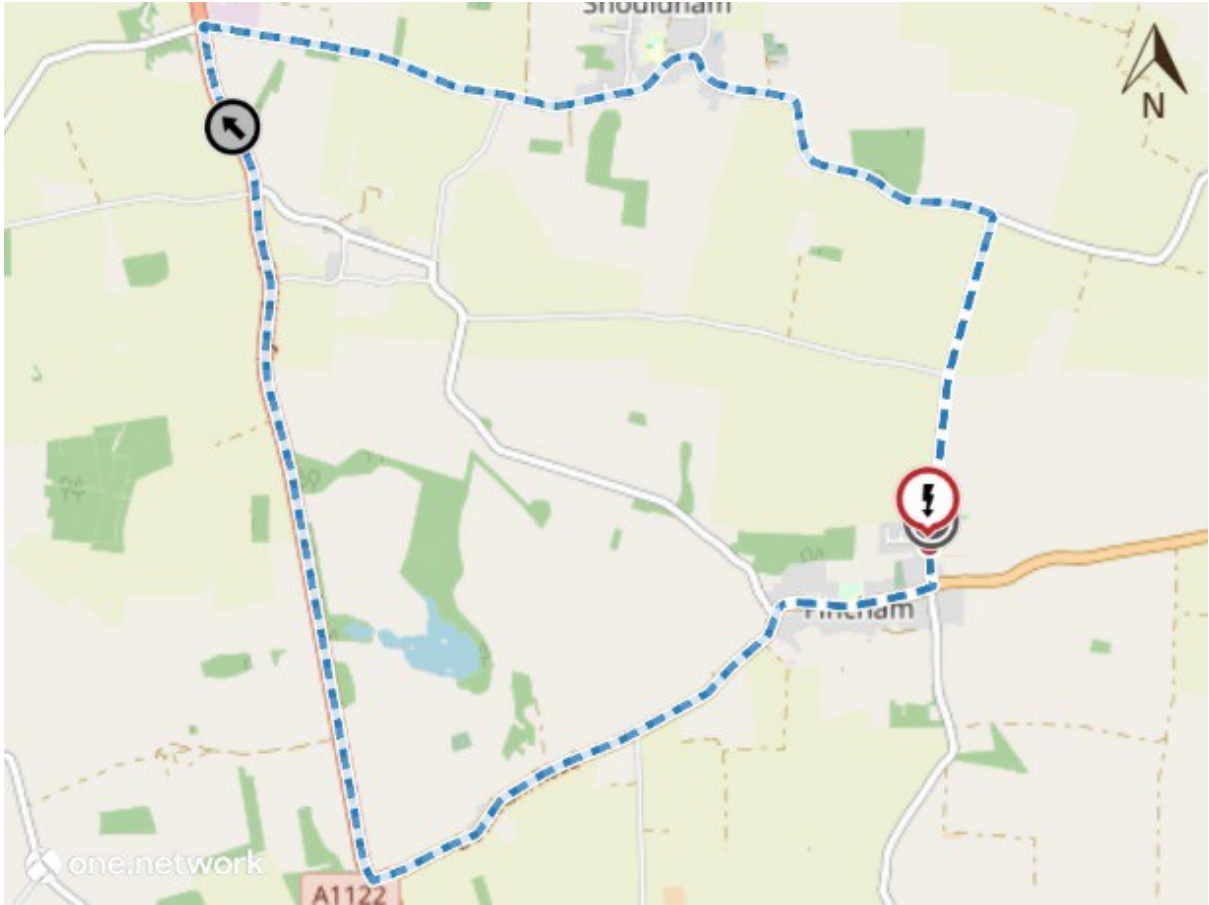
Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
