NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (WTRO4944) affecting the High Street from 240m west of its junction with Boughton Road for 50m westwards in the PARISH OF FINCHAM to facilitate new connection works by Anglian Water.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) from 29th to 31st May 2024 for the duration of the works expected to be about 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: High Street, Downham Road, Fincham Road, Stow Bridge Road, Stow Bardolph Bypass A10, Downham/ Wimbotsham Bypass, Lynn Road, Main Road, West Winch Road, A47 J A10/A149 larger of two Roundabouts, A47 Trunk Road from the Pullover Roundabout to the Hardwick Roundabout, Queen Elizabeth Way, Constitution Hill, A47 J A10/A149 Link Road from larger to smaller Roundabout east, A47 J A10/A149 smaller of two Roundabouts, A47 from J B1153 to J A10/A149, Norwich Road, Magpie Farm Road, A47 from J A1122 To J B1153, A47 J A1122 Roundabout, Swaffham Road, Boughton Road (Watlington, Stow Bardolph, Barton Bendish, Swaffham, Beachamwell, Stradsett, Fincham, Narford, Narborough, North Runcton, Wimbotsham, East Winch, Pentney, West Winch Crimplesham, Tottenhill, Middleton, Runcton Holme).

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order.


Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
